Daradgee Specific Elaborations

This experience may require students to:

- observe the offspring of aquatic life
- identify the ways humans can manage and protect resources, such as catch and release fishing
- recognise that many living things rely on resources that may be threatened eg. reed beds
- research with the use of fish traps
- make observations and sort aquatic animals based on easily recognisable features
- discuss what was discovered with other students
- represent observations through digital photography
