This experience may require students to:

- consider the effects of physical conditions eg. excessive heat reduces egg production, incubator temperature may influence gender
- investigate irreversible changes such as composting and worm farming
- explore how reversible changes can be used to recycle materials
- consider how personal and community choices can influence our practices relating to sustainability
- use digital photography to represent and describe observations
