Daradgee Specific Elaborations

This experience may require students to:

- explain how particular adaptations help BMI's survival eg. nocturnal behaviour, living underwater, diet, camouflage
- describe and list adaptations of BMI's eg. Mayfly nymph gills, dragon fly nymph air sac
- develop an understanding of the relationship between BMI's and their habitats, particularly focusing on their adaptations to survive in water catchments eg. detritus diet
- use digital cameras to share ideas
