Students describe the properties and behaviour of familiar objects. They suggest how the environment affects them and other living things. Students share and reflect on observations, and ask and respond to questions about familiar objects and events.

Daradgee Specific Elaborations

This experience may require students to:

- share observations with others and communicate their experiences
- explore and observe using the senses: hearing, touch, sight
- use sight, hearing and touch so that students can gather information about the world around them
- take part in informal and guided discussions relating to students' observations
